Policy Export – What Happens?

AirLift Converts existing Group Policies to Windows 10 CSPs

- Group Policy to MDM CSPs
- Validation for compatibility
- Search and Filter by GPO or subject
- Filter by Win10 Versions
- Export policies in batch

Plan the right approach for each use case

- AirLift – Third party ADMX, SyncML mgt, MDM priority
- Baselines – GPO to GPO, coverage is priority, Benchmarks

Destination

- Over the air policy management
- No reliance on GPupdate, VPN, or domain
- Optimize for Modern Management or Coverage and Control
